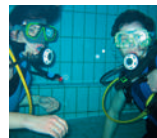

Cycling around Lake Constance

Starting point Friedrichshafen – train connections, useful transport options via boat, catamaran and ferry, offer ideal conditions for your cycling holiday. The scenic Lake Constance cycle path invites guests to enjoy the lake and the idyllic towns in the Lake Constance region. Experienced cyclists find challenging routes with magnificent views in the beautiful and hilly surroundings.

From Friedrichshafen to Lindau

This route holds a wealth of wonderful experiences in store. In the nature reserve "Eriskircher Ried", you find yourself in the midst of a flora and fauna which is still undisturbed by human influence. Shortly after the marsh, you arrive at "Schloss Montfort", the landmark of Langenargen. Continuing, you cross the cable suspension bridge, known as the little version of the Golden Gate Bridge. We particularly recommend a detour along the banks of the river Argen into the beautiful surrounding area of Lake Constance to the moated castle of Gießen. Back on the shores of the lake, you cycle through orchards which remind you of paradise, Nonnenhorn and the peninsular Wasserburg. Having passed Bad Schachen, the finishing point of the leg is the medieval island town Lindau. You may return to Friedrichshafen by ship or train.

Hiking in and around Friedrichshafen

Tracing history

The 3 km-long historic trail featuring 50 information signs accessible to everyone, present all aspects of the town's history and lead interested parties on historic paths through Friedrichshafen.

Bodenseepfad (Lake Constance Trail and nature reserve centre)

On illustrated signs in the Eriskircher Ried, the largest nature reserve at the northern shore, and along the Friedrichshafen lakeside promenade, walkers find out more about the flora and fauna as well as the natural attraction of the Lake Constance area. A permanent exhibition in the nature reserve centre offers fascinating sights into Lake Constance's animal and plant worlds. A multi-media show with wonderful photos completes the offer. **Free entry to the nature reserve centre!** **Approx. 7 km, paved and natural paths.**

Ortsrundweg Kluftern & Bodensee Kunstwege

This 12.5 km long trail, in the shape of a large eight, features a north and a south loop, and is an art, nature and historic trail full of variety. It passes by legendary sites, old buildings and meadow orchards, biotopes, as well as large sculptures of well-known local artists, and tells the history of the village through the Middle Ages and right back to the Stone Age.

Königsweg – (The King's Road, which is named after König Wilhelm I)

The idyllic path near the lake, overshadowed by tall trees, leads from Friedrichshafen to Fischbach. The Königsweg was the connecting path between the castle and the agricultural domain in Manzell. The path leads past the historic castle bridge to the Baroque Palace Church, the landmark of Friedrichshafen, and on to the recently opened shoreline path.

Approx. 5 km, paved and natural path.

Panoramaweg Ailingen (scenic path Ailingen)

Starting from the town hall in Ailingen, via Unterlottenweiler and towards Horach, this path leads to the highest point of Friedrichshafen which offers a beautiful panoramic view over the lake and the Alps. Past the Höhlerösch, a protected wet meadow, you arrive at the Haldenbergkapelle (chapel), which is situated on top of the Haldenberg with probably the best view in Friedrichshafen.



From the chapel, you walk past idyllic meadows down to the Fasanenweg, then on to the Haldenberg and the Gartenstraße, which leads you straight to the small park by the town hall. **Approx. 9 km, paved and natural paths.**
